Reading/Language Arts	Know that a sentence has two parts , the beginning which is the subject and the end of the sentence which is the predicate . The subject is always a noun (person, place or thing) and the predicate always begins with a verb (action word or linking verb such as is, are, has, have, etc). Remember that the problem in the story explains what went wrong with a character and the solution explains how the character fixes what went wrong .
Math	Know how to round numbers up to the nearest hundred . Know the value of each coin . Be able to count mixed coins .
Science	Know that soil is made up of water, air and humus . Know that humus has bits of dead plants and animals in it. Know the different kinds of soil, sand, clay and silt . Be able to explain why soil is important to all of us.
Social Studies	Know what natural resources are and be able to give examples . Be able to explain the difference between renewable and nonrenewable resources . Be able to explain ways to conserve resources (recycle, reduce and reuse)
