<b>Reading/Language Arts</b>	Know the <b>elements of a story</b> . Know the <b>problem explains what went wrong in the story and that the solution explains how the problem was solved</b> . Know that a <b>command (imperative) sentence tells someone to do something, ends with a period and an exclamatory sentence shows strong feeling and ends with an exclamation mark</b> .
<b>Math</b>	Know the <b>commutative, associative and zero properties of addition</b> . Know <b>that knowing how to solve addition and subtraction problems mentally helps you add and subtract faster</b> .
<b>Science</b>	Know that a <b>mineral is a natural substance</b> . Know that <b>rocks are made of minerals</b> . Be able to give examples of each. Know that <b>you test the hardness of a mineral with a scratch test</b> .
<b>Social Studies</b>	Know that the <b>USA is a democratic nation, meaning it is governed by the people</b> . Know that the concept of <b>democracy began in Athens, Greece</b> . Know that the Parthenon is the building that was the model for <b>government buildings in the U.S.</b>
