Vocabulary/Spelling Words for the week	<i>diversity cultural global awareness similarities differences</i> <i>currency pollution recycle</i> <i>Long a and Long e words</i>
Reading/Language Arts	Know the elements of a story . The plot tells what happened in the beginning, middle and end of the story . The characters are the animals or people in the story , and the setting tells when and where the story takes place . Know the problem explains what went wrong in the story and that the solution explains how the problem was solved . Know that a command (imperative) sentence tells someone to do something , ends with a period and an exclamatory sentence shows strong feeling and ends with an exclamation mark .
Math	Know there are different ways to solve word problems . Know clue words such as in all, how many more, etc. Know which operation to choose when you see the clue words . Know the value of a place up to the thousands. Know how to write a number in expanded form (i.e. $434 = 400+30+4$)
Science	Know the names of the three types of rocks . (igneous, metamorphic, sedimentary). Be able to explain how rocks form .
Social Studies	Know that the USA is a democratic nation , meaning it is governed by the people . Know that the concept of democracy began in Athens, Greece . Know that the Parthenon is the building that was the model for government buildings in the U.S.
