<b>Reading/Language Arts</b>	Know that <b>a sentence has two parts</b> , the beginning which is the <b>subject</b> and the end of the sentence which is the <b>predicate</b> . The <b>subject is always a noun</b> (person, place or thing) and the <b>predicate always begins with a verb</b> (action word or linking verb such as is, are, has, have, etc). Remember that the <b>problem in the story explains what went wrong with a character</b> and the <b>solution explains how the character fixes what went wrong</b> .
<b>Math</b>	Know what each coin looks like and know <b>the value of each coin</b> . Be able to <b>use a number sentence or mental math to count mixed coins</b> . <b>Know that coins are a form of currency</b> .
<b>Science</b>	Know that soil is made up of water, air and humus. Know that humus has bits of dead plants and animals in it. Know the different kinds of soil, sand, clay and silt.
<b>Social Studies</b>	Know that the <b>USA is a democratic nation, meaning it is governed by the people</b> . Know that the concept of <b>democracy began in Athens, Greece</b> . Know that the <b>Parthenon is the building that was the model for government buildings in the U.S.</b>
