Math	Know the <b>value of each coin</b> . Be able to <b>use subtraction to figure out change</b> . Be able to <b>use coin combinations to create different amounts</b> .
Science	Be able to explain how fossils are formed. Be able to name the different types of fossils (cast, amber, petrified).
Social Studies	Be able to explain what happens to land and soil over time. (Erosion, weathering)
